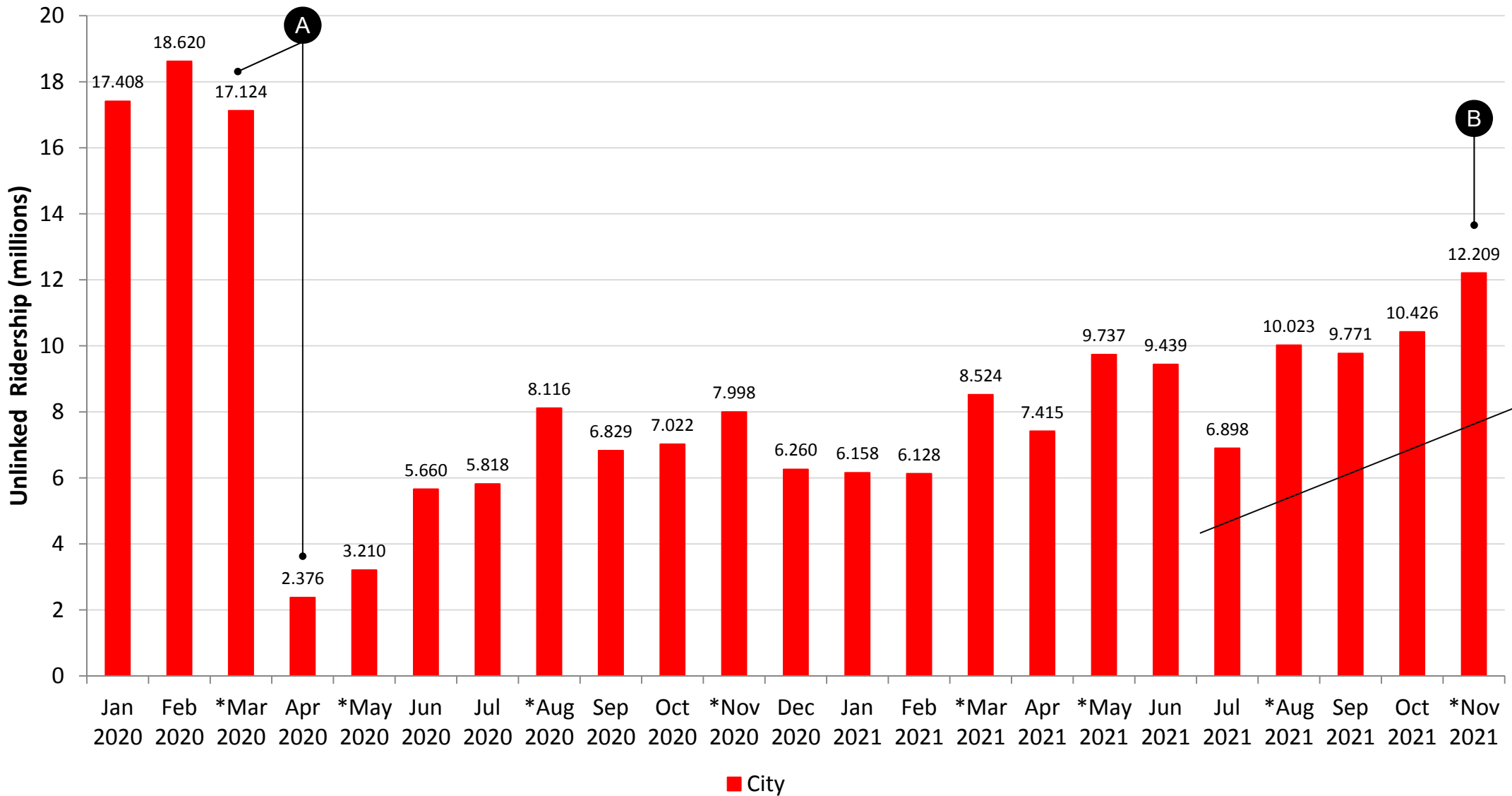


SEPTA Unlinked City Ridership from January 2020 to November 2021



A Comparing Apr 2020 to Mar 2020, City ridership dropped 86%, from 17.1 to 2.4 million.

B City ridership still well below pre-COVID levels in Nov 2021 at 12.2 million, but highest month since the onset of the pandemic; encouraging trend upward in ridership since July 2021.

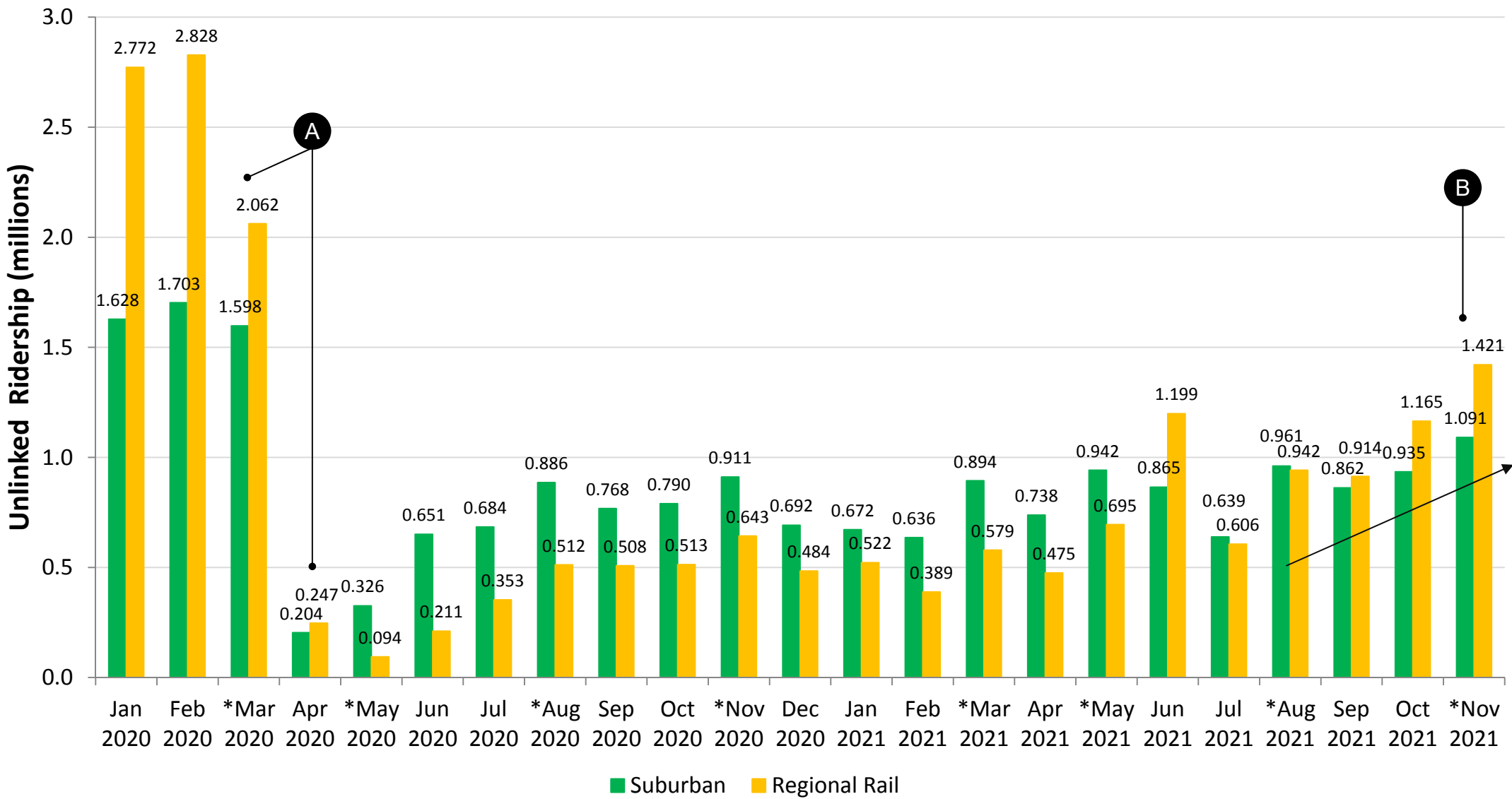

SEPTA Unlinked Suburban and Regional Rail Ridership from January 2020 to November 2021

A Comparing Apr 2020 to Mar 2020, Suburban and Regional Rail ridership dropped 87% and 88%, respectively.

B Suburban ridership, and even more so Regional rail ridership, are well below pre-COVID levels in November 2021 at 1.091 million and 1.421 million, respectively.



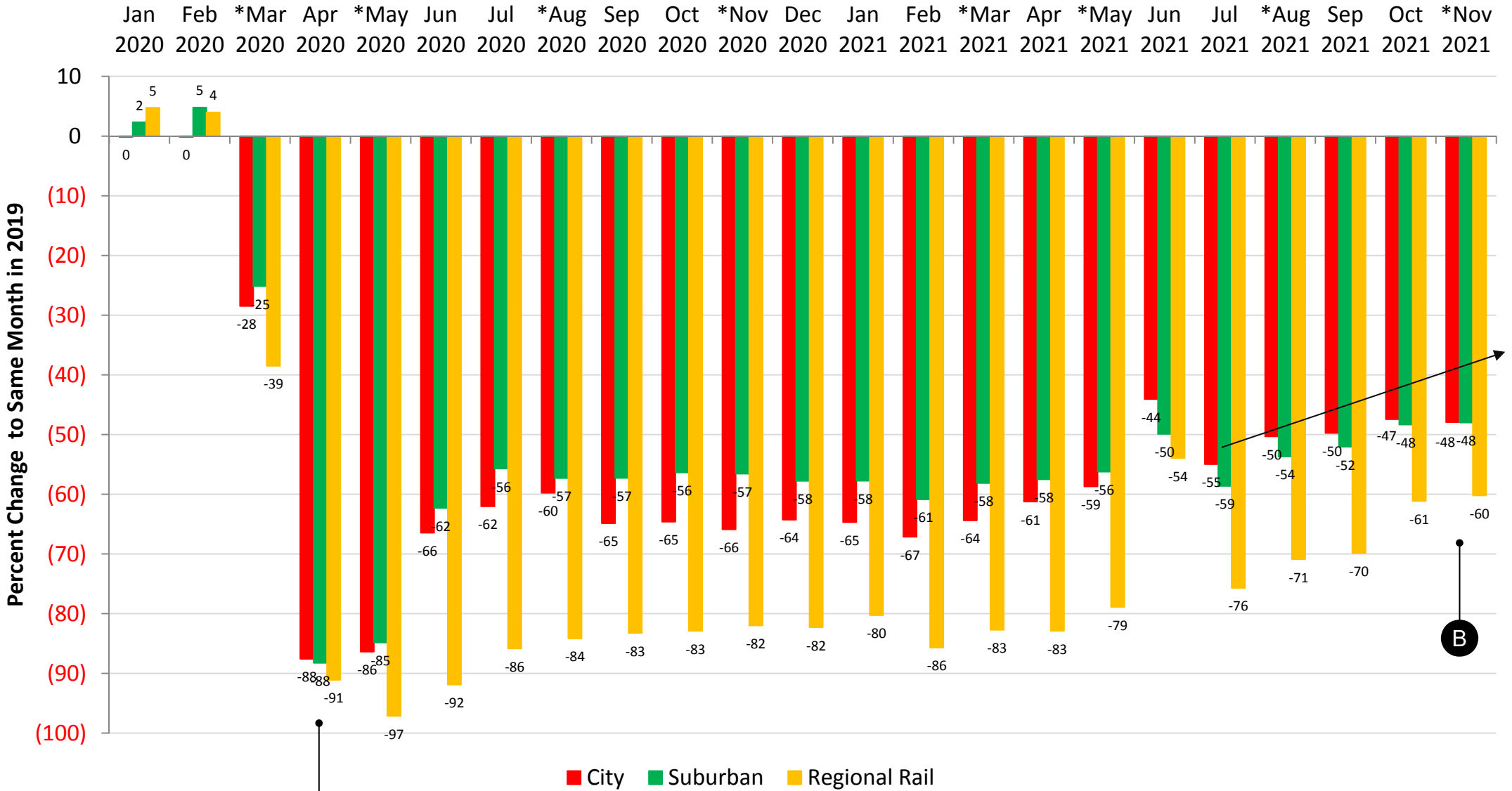

SEPTA Percent Change in Ridership Compared to 2019 Baseline

A Significant drop in ridership in Apr 2020 for all transit types with City and Suburban down 88%, and Regional Rail down by 91%.

B City and Suburban ridership in Nov 2021 still down 48% and Regional Rail down 60%, compared to Nov 2019, but trending toward pre-pandemic levels.
