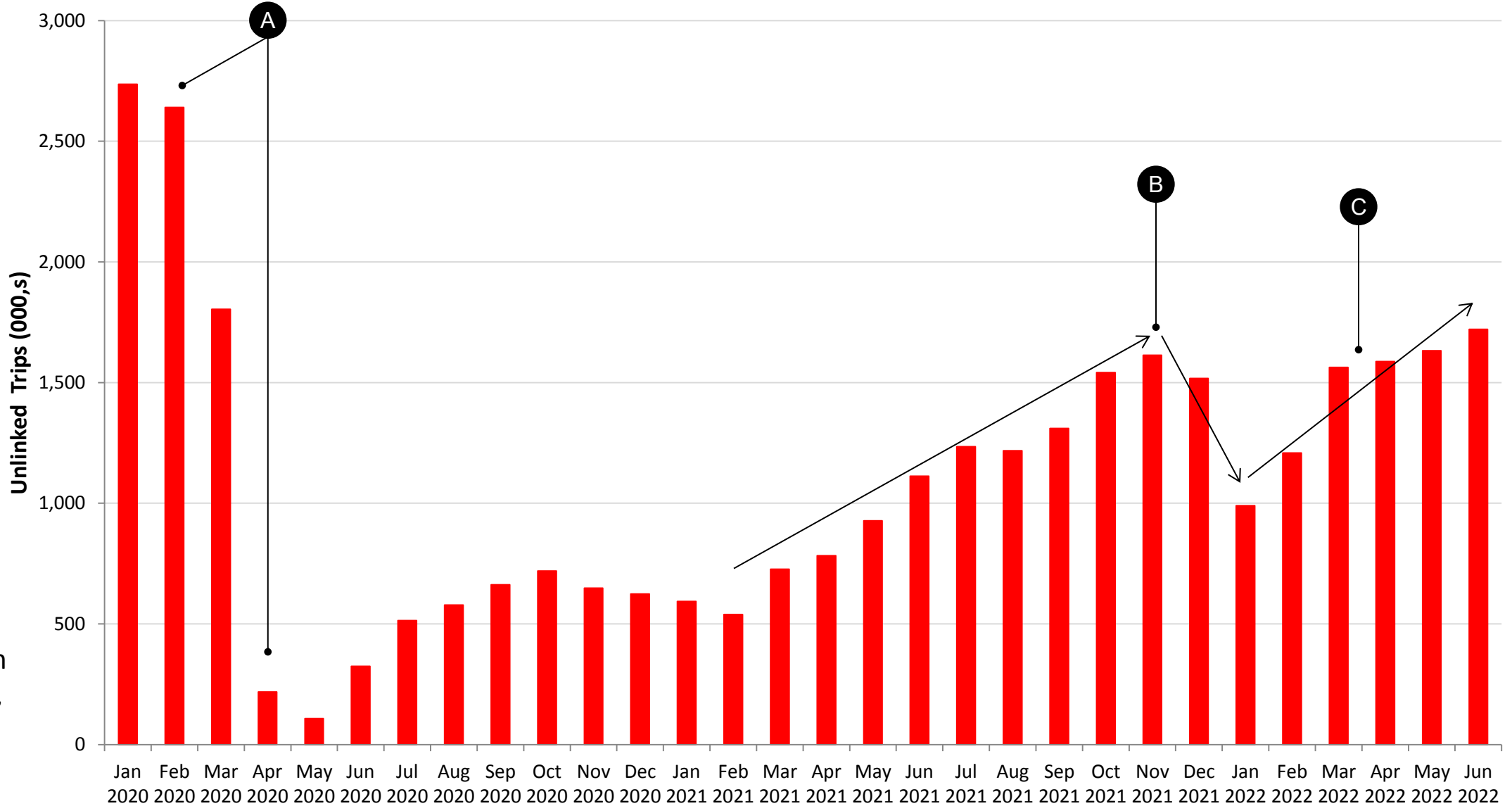


NJ Transit Northeast Corridor Unlinked Passenger Trips from Jan 2020 to Jun 2022

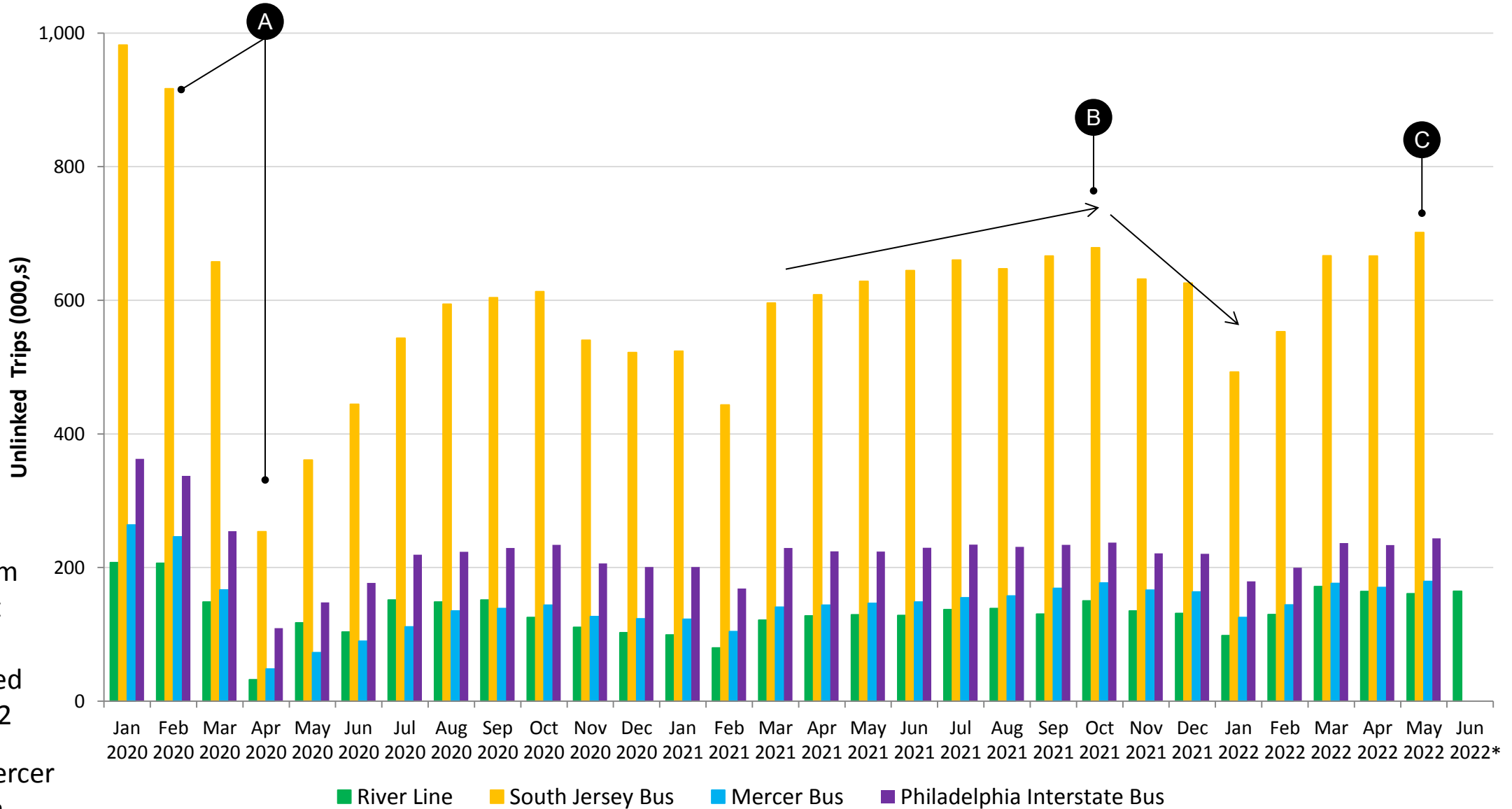
- A** Comparing Feb 2020 to Apr 2020, NE Corridor trips dropped 92%, from 2.640M to 219K
- B** Trips gradually increased from Feb 2021 to Nov 2021 by about 200% to 1.614M
- C** Trips declined from Nov 2021 to Jan 2022 from 1.614M to 990K, but have since rebounded to 1.721M in Jun 2022

NJ Transit River Line and Regional Bus Unlinked Passenger Trips from Jan 2020 to Jun 2022



A Comparing Feb 2020 to Apr 2020, River Line, South Jersey, Mercer and Philadelphia Interstate Bus trips dropped 85%, 72%, 80% and 68%, respectively

B Trips mostly increased for all transit types from Mar 2021 to Oct 2021, but then gradually dropped through Jan 2022

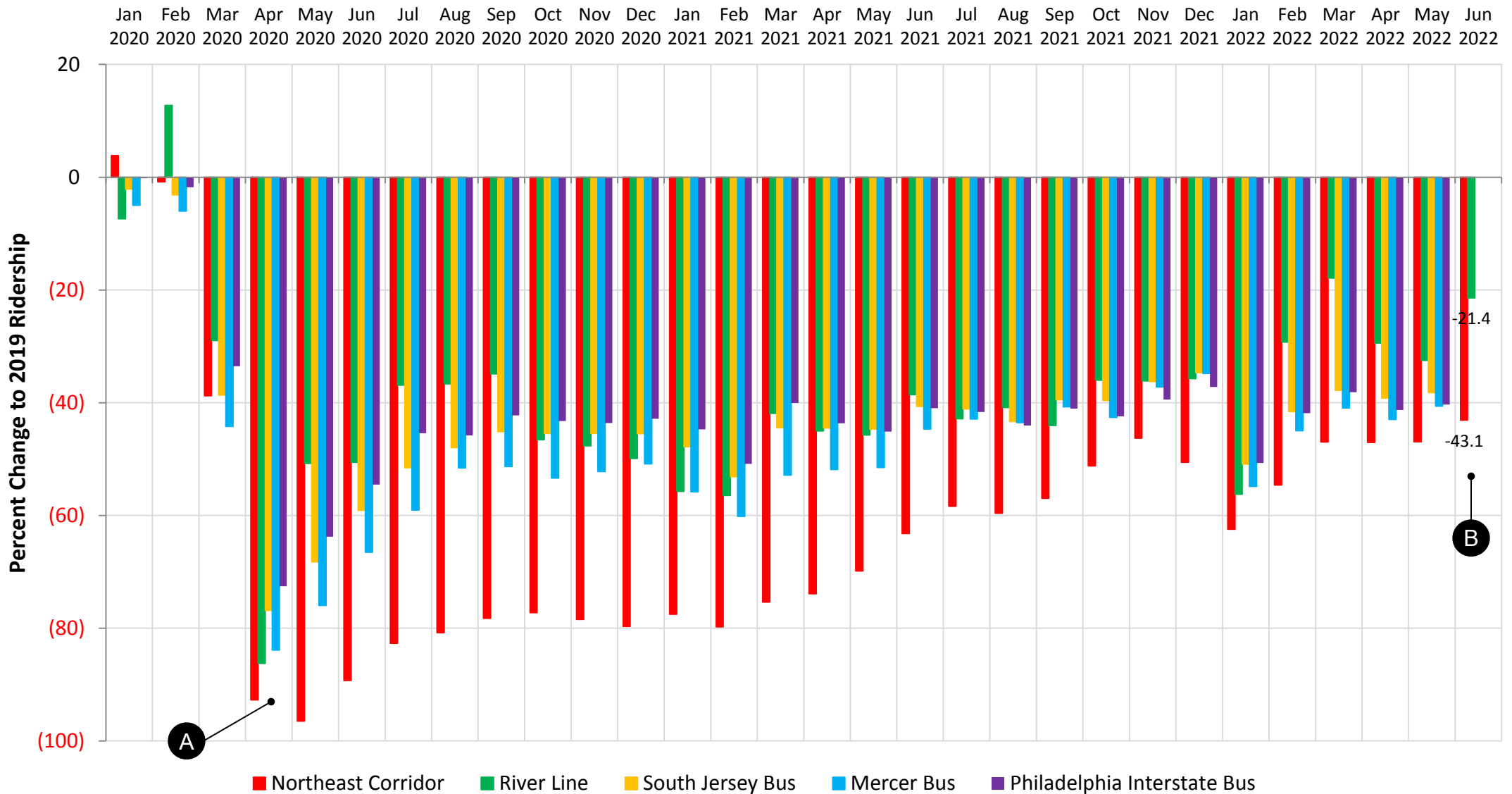
C South Jersey, Mercer and Philadelphia Interstate Bus highest since Feb 2020

A Comparing Apr 2019 to Apr 2020, NE Corridor and River Line trips dropped about 93% and 86%, respectively

B Comparing Jun 2019 to Jun 2022, NE Corridor and River Line trips down 43% and 21%, respectively
